Tour Itinerary

Tues., Apr. 1 - SOUTH MILWAUKEE / EN ROUTE

Our journey begins as we transfer from South Milwaukee to Chicago O'Hare International Airport where we board our Aer Lingus non-stop trans-Atlantic flight traveling to Dublin, Ireland. (I)

Wed., Apr. 2 - DUBLIN / KILKENNY

As the sun rises on the Irish coast we arrive in Dublin. We are met by our Irish Driver/Guide who will travel with us throughout our holiday. We are headed to a local farm in the village of Ballybaught to see sheepdogs at work. A wonderful location where we experience a taste of pastoral life. In this relaxed atmosphere, the hard working sheepdogs will leave you feeling enchanted. See if you can whistle and command the dogs or simply sit back, relax and enjoy as Michael and his sheepdogs do their work with the sheep. This afternoon we continue to the medieval city of Kilkenny, one of Ireland's most cosmopolitan cities, a gem in the heart of Ireland's Ancient East and our hotel. Dinner is included this evening at our hotel. (I,D)

Thurs., Apr. 3 – KILKENNY

Our walking tour of Kilkenny will introduce us to the Medieval past, we hear about the Kilkenny witch, Dame Alice Kyteler and Shee Alms House. We will meander through the famous Slip ways, Tholsel Story of Kilkenny Cats, Oliver Cromwell City Walls, the Gate Ghost Stories Churches, and all the Kilkenny characters of times past. Next we enter the peaceful grounds of Kilkenny Castle for a tour of this magnificently restored castle. Just opposite the Castle, be sure to take a peek into the Kilkenny Design Center, a well-curated shop featuring the work of Irish artisans. A visit to Kilkenny isn't complete without the Smithwick's Experience! Immerse yourself in the story of Smithwick's, told as only a local knows how. Where 300 years of history combine with extraordinary brewing innovations, to create the Smithwick's tour - an experience like no other. (B)

Fri., Apr. 4 – KILKENNY / KILLARNEY

We bid farewell to Kilkenny and drive to the fabled Blarney Castle. We'll have an opportunity to climb the steps of the fortress to see the world-famous Blarney Stone. Just a stone's throw away we'll also visit the Blarney Woolen Mills, the largest emporium of Irish crafts in the country where you can browse the finely woven Irish woolen products or relax at one of its





welcoming pubs. Next, we discover the Heart and Soul of Irish whiskey at Midleton Distillery Experience. Home of seven iconic brands including Jameson. Midleton Distillery Experience is a one-of-a-kind whiskey experience that takes you beyond process and taste and brings you to the very essence of Irish whiskey. Taste, learn, shop, and take in the magic of Midleton. This afternoon we drive into the Kingdom of Kerry and magical Killarney. Set in the scenic southwest, it is here where we'll find some of the most picturesque views in all of Ireland, along with incredible people, food, and pubs! Dinner is included at our hotel. (B,D)

Sat., Apr. 5 – KILLARNEY (Dingle Peninsula)

After breakfast we drive via the town of Killorglin and out along the Dingle Peninsula. Our journey takes us along the scenic road, which winds along the shoreline and through hilly countryside, enjoying spectacular views of mountains and the coast, with new vistas opening up at every turn. We stop in the delightful town of Dingle before driving to the very tip of the peninsula to see the Gallarus Oratory, built in the 6th century of un-mortared stone and still watertight after 14 centuries. We return to Killarney where the remainder of the day is free for individual pursuits. Dine in one of the many pubs and restaurants or you may like to find a "singing bar" for traditional Irish entertainment. (B)

Sun., Apr. 6 – KILLARNEY

Today we explore Killarney National Park, Ireland's oldest national park, the traditional way by horse and carriage, which is known locally as a "Killarney jaunting car." You'll ride in the carriage with woolen blankets to keep you warm on cooler days, and enjoy a scenic route around the Muckross Park Estate to the historic Muckross Abbey. Even better, the experience is private, so you'll ride with just your personal group. Another evening to experience the amazing pubs of Killarney. (B)



Mon., Apr. 7 - KILLARNEY / DUBLIN

This morning we leave Killarney and drive to the village of Adare. Billed as Ireland's prettiest village, we'll have an opportunity to stroll along the town's Main Street of thatched houses, colorfully painted storefronts and beautiful gardens. This afternoon we make our way back to County Dublin and the capital city of Dublin. (B,D)

Tues., Apr. 8 – DUBLIN

Today we meet a local Dublin guide that will take us on a fascinating sightseeing tour through Dublin. We'll end our tour with a visit to the Guinness Storehouse to experience the Guinness Story and the brewing process before finishing with a sampling of their wonderful stout in the Visitors Bar. Following our tour, time at leisure will allow us to stroll pedestrian Grafton Street where you'll find plenty of shopping and Bewley's Café Theatre, a city landmark or to explore the pubs in Temple Bar. All too soon our vacation in Ireland has come to an end. Transfer to Dublin Airport in plenty of time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your flight returning us to Chicago. On arrival we board our motor coach to return to the South Milwaukee. (B,I)
